The radial highway common carrier identified by the captioned "T" identification number as assigned by the Commission, having made written application to the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for a certificate to operate as a HIGHWAY COMMON CARRIER and having complied with section 1063.5 of the Public Utilities Code, is granted this certificate authorizing the transportation of property for compensation by motor vehicle over public highways of the State of California as a HIGHWAY COMMON CARRIER, as defined in section 213 of said Code, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Said carrier shall comply with all orders, decisions, rules, regulations, directions and requirements governing the operations of said carrier, issued, published, prescribed or adopted by this Commission pursuant to said code.
- (2) To the extent that this certificate duplicates in whole or part, or any other certificate authority held by the carrier or granted in the future, such operative rights may not be separated to the allow the sale or transfer of one or more such duplicating rights or portion thereof and the retention of another certificated right to perform the same service.
- (3) This certificate will supersede all highway carrier permit authority held by the carrier to the extent that this certificate authorizes the specific transportation performed and the carrier's rates, rules and charges for such common carrier transportation are legally on file with the Commission.
- (4) This certificate shall not be sold, assigned, leased or otherwise transferred or encumbered without first obtaining Commission authorization.
- (5) This certificate is subject to the appendix hereto which is made a part hereof.
- (6) Transportation authorized by this certificate is for general commodities within the State of California excluding the following:
 1. Used household goods, personal effects and office, store and institution furniture, fixtures and equipment not packed in salesmen's hand sample cases, suitcases, overnight or boston bags, briefcases, hat boxes, valises, traveling bags, trunks, lift vans, barrels, boxes, cartons, crates, cases, baskets, pails, kits, tubs, drums, bags (jute, cotton, burlap, or gunny) or bundles (completely wrapped in jute, cotton, burlap, gunny, fibreboard, or straw matting) except when transported in vehicles containing any other type of freight subject to this certificate.
 2. Livestock, viz.: Barrows, boars, bulls, butcher hogs, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, feeder pigs, gilts, goats, heifers, hogs, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, rams (bucks), sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags, swine, or wethers.
 3. Petroleum or petroleum products in tank trucks or tank trailers.
 4. Mining, building, paving and construction material, except cement or liquids, when transported in bulk in dump-type trucks or trailers or hopper-type trucks or trailers.
 5. Portland or similar cements in bulk or packages, when loaded substantially to capacity of motor vehicle.
 6. Other commodities:
 7. Transportation to, from or within the following county(ies).

This certificate is granted June 14, 1979, is effective thirty days thereafter, and is issued January 31, 1980.
